We all have dreams, small or big, but most of us can fulfill our dreams, however, sick children can't, so, Mrs. Meron among other things is here to fulfill these dreams. Unfortunately, there are children that even the medical treatment can't help them, this stage is unbearable and the family is broken and painful. We strive to fulfill the children's wishes and make them as happy as possible. Wishes vary from child to child especially because of different ages. In most cases, children are asking for expensive presents or trips for the whole family, but as we know nothing is more perches than raising smiles on children whose days are numbered.

When the child asks for a trip abroad, it is a trip that should be accompanied by a full medical staff including volunteers, a joyful experience full of excitements. A complete cut off from the illness, getting out of hospital to a fantasy world, a visit to Disney or a meeting with the German chancellor as well as giving them gifts that are heartwarming, unfortunately, children who do not survive the disease will hold on till the last minute to the experiences and souvenirs from their dream trip.

Fulfilling all this costs a lot and therefore the museum will be happy if you help with donation.

Once the child is discovered with the disease, life is changed. The parents live in constant stress, focusing on the child medical tests results, hospital treatment and long hospitalizations that in some cases involve isolation of the child for weeks, leaving him without his family on weekends and holidays. Mrs. Meron will take care of the families, treating them with a visit to all the possible attractions with the participation of clowns, artisans and celebrities who come with medical staff and volunteers for the purpose of making the children happy. The costs are enormous, so the museum will be happy to receive any donations.

Children who receive chemotherapy can't be in their usual environment because their immune system is particularly weak, depending on their medical condition between treatments, Mrs. Meron will make sure to take the kids out of the hospital for a special personal day of fun, and this is especially suited to the children's medical condition. These days give joy to the children and cost a lot so the museum will appreciate any donation.

Girls and women indulge themselves in arranging their hair; girls who are being treated with chemotherapy lose their hair and become bald, something which causes them great sorrow and they do not want to leave the house looking like this. Many families do not have the financial ability to buy a natural wig that will return the girl's natural appearance and so the girls remain bald. Mrs. Meron will do all she can to make sure that every girl who lost her hair will have a natural hair wig and look just like she looked before. The cost of such a wig is about 1500 Euros, so the museum and Mrs. Meron will appreciate any help.

Children with cancer are treated almost daily with chemotherapy, which weakens the immune system and requires a visit to the doctor almost every day. Usually one of the parents leaves their jobs and the other stays to be with the child, something which causes financial hardship. There are families that can't drive their children for treatment so, those children arrive by public transport and endanger their lives. The museum is about to purchase a vehicle that will take the children to hospitals for treatments and return them to their homes at no cost.

During the difficult period and the painful treatments, the child goes through dramatic days which change his vision on life and surrounding. One day a year when we look forward to spoil the child on his/her birthdays, we hold a birthday party celebrating personally every child on his birthday at the museum of clowns, inviting his/her friends to a special party, a unique production in which we ask the child how would he/she like to celebrate the birthday and immediately, we start working on fulfilling their wishes.
